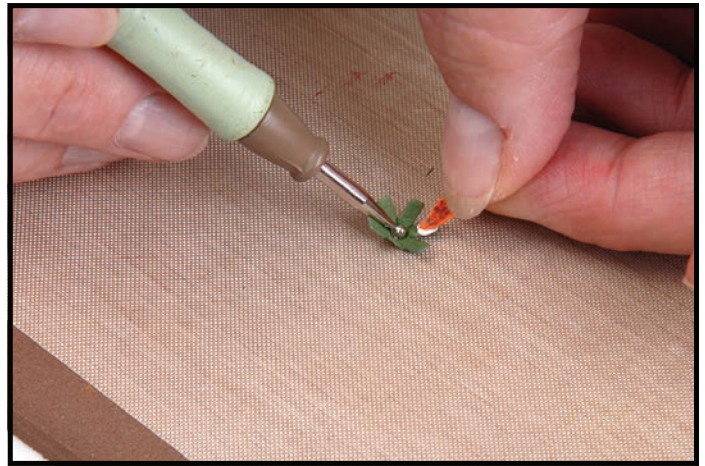


## 658408 Sizzix® Thinlits™ Die - Flower, Mini Lily by Susan Tierney Cockburn



1. Die-cut petals from colored cardstock of your choice. Die-cut leaves and the calyx (Flower base) from medium green cardstock. Cut the stamen from bright green cardstock. Add shading and "freckles" using Fan Pastels™ and Copic® markers.



2. **Shape, line, pinch** and **bend** petals to give dimension. **Form** the calyx into a cup. Dip stem end of petals in glue and adhere to calyx, evenly spacing three petals.



3. Place the other three petals slightly closer to the center between each of the first three petals. Allow Flower to dry.



4. Dot ends of the stamen with marker for color. **Roll** the stamen. Use a toothpick to place a small dab of glue on the end of the stamen and seal.



5. Apply a small amount of glue with a toothpick to the stamen. Dip the stamen into Woodland Scenics™ Pollen to add a natural look. Dip the base of the stamen into glue and adhere it to the center of the Flower.



6. **Line** the leaves with the leaf tool by dragging two or three lines lengthwise down the leaf. **Shape** the leaves slightly, then **pinch** and **bend**. Set Flower in place and tuck leaves around to finish.
