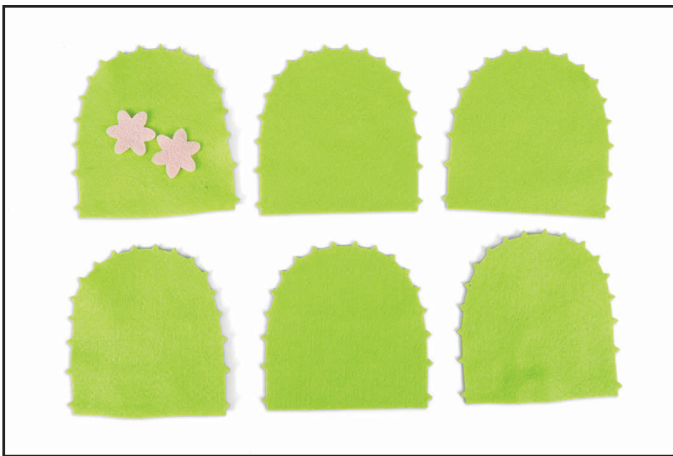
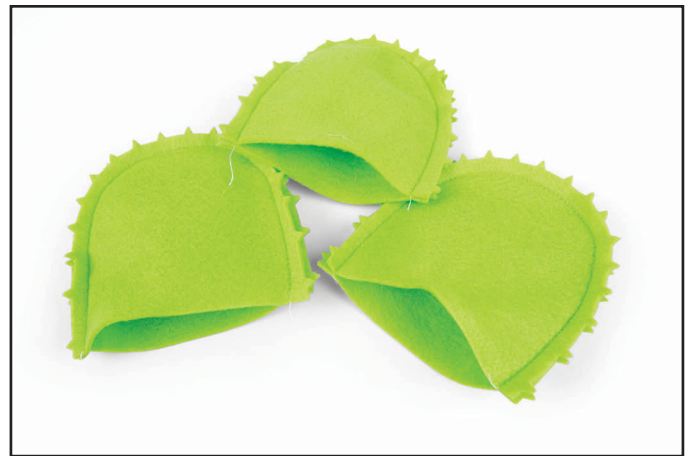




FABRIC



1. Die-cut six cactus shapes and two blossoms out of desired fabric.



2. Sew the cactus shapes together in pairs, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.



3. Stack the sewn shapes, and sew them together from top to bottom.



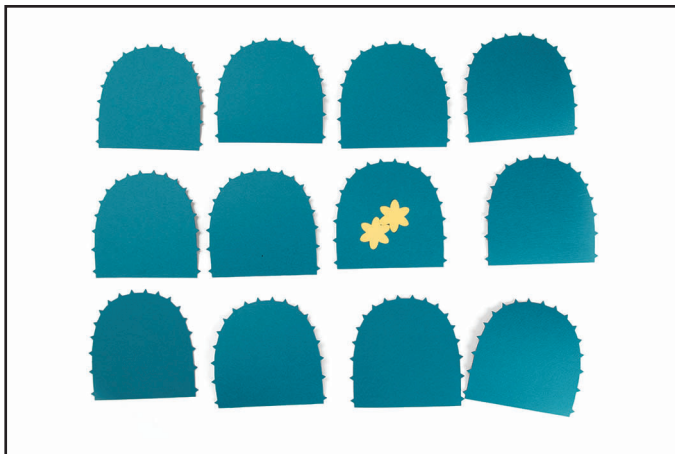
4. Fill each pocket with batting, and hand stitch to close.



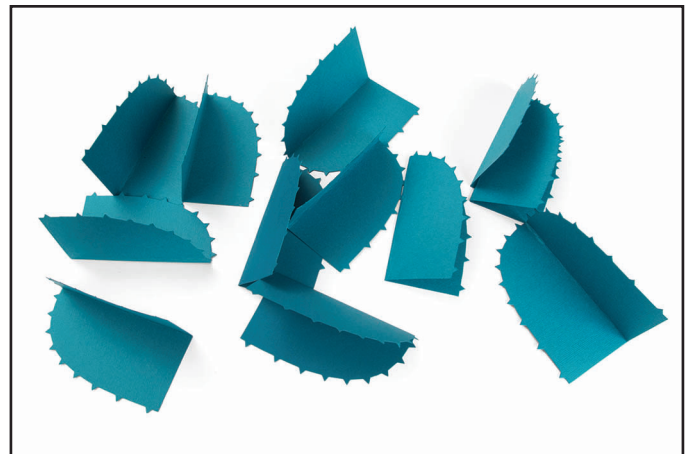
5. Offset two blossom pieces, and sew them together. Sew the finished blossom to the top of the cactus.



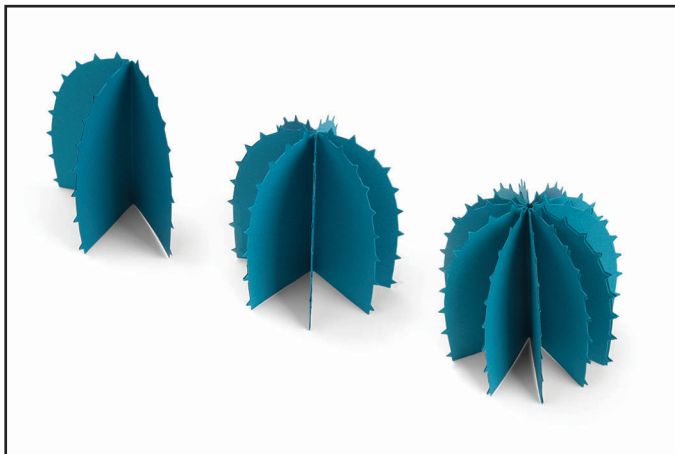
PAPER



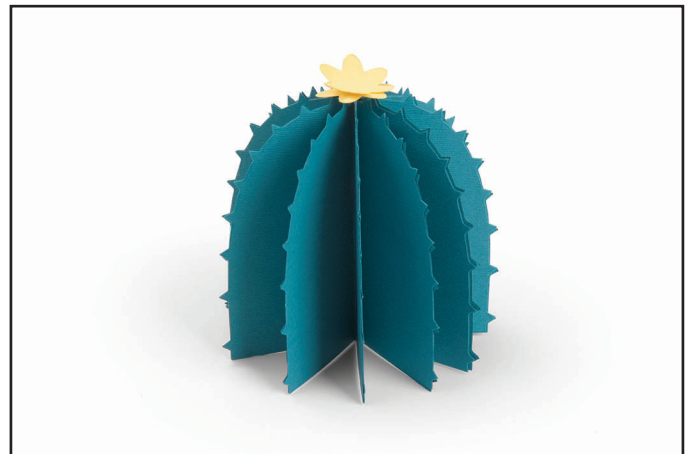
1. Die-cut 12 cactus and 2 blossom shapes out of desired material.



2. Fold each of the cactus shapes in half.



3. Adhere the folded panels together.



4. Offset two blossom pieces, and adhere them together. Adhere the finished blossom to the top of the cactus.
